5. AIMS AND OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:

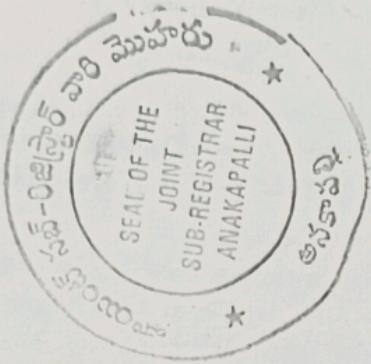
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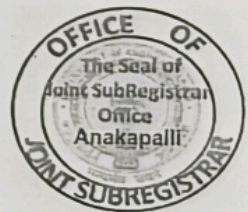
7. To conduct camps. and socio clinics to educate people about HIV, AIDS, CANCER, Diabetes, Malaria, Filarial, Dengue' and all other Contagious Diseases, to educate about adverse effects of alcoholism and to stress the importance of sanitation, Civic Sense, Clean and Green to involve in Swatch Bharath Programmers, Surroundings: Environment and Global Warming etc. To take up all kinds of projects relating to conservation and protection nature and environment to prevent and reduce the damage caused by the human and industrial activities. To provide environmental education and awareness.
8. To establish, maintain, promote, run, manage, support, fund, grant, innovate, design, develop, collaborate with, supervise and assist any person or body directly or indirectly, that involved in the achievements of same goals. Promotion of sustainable agriculture and natural resources management. Preservation of ecological and environmental balance.
9. To strengthen the capabilities of NGOS, Government Organizations, Institutions etc.
10. To carry on any activity or activities of charitable nature and of Public utility good.
11. To promote and assist research and development in all branches of science and technology, to promote public awareness and to generally promote and assist the implementation of social welfare measures and to engage in public charitable activities and any activity of general public utility and good.
12. To undertake and assist all kinds of tribal, rural and urban development activities To undertake relief for the needy by all conceivable means, especially relating to relief at times of natural and other calamities. Improvement of basic amenities like Water supply, electricity, roads, transport, drainage and sanitation, town and country planning, development of education, medical and health care, Women and child welfare, development of education medical and cottage industries, industrial and agriculture development and for purposes of achievement of the aforesaid agricultural development and for purposes of achievement of aforesaid objects to establish maintain and run educational institutions, hospitals and health centers, to organize research and training centers, laboratories, Workshops, and the like and to interact with and make representations before public bodies and authorities in pursuance of the main objectives.
13. To amalgamate merge any Trust, society, Association, Organization, Institution, Corporation or Body With this Trust for furthering the objects of this Trust.
14. To propagate, enhance, maintain spiritual and cultural values and awareness among people for their well being and fulfillment of their lives and check Degeneration everywhere and to ensure Regeneration of people/ individuals / societies /nations/and the world.
15. To Establish, promote and maintain schools, colleges, conduct tuition classes, education centers, research centers publication houses through oral, audio, video mode and methods with a view to inculcate, promote the scriptures and works, principles teachings and nationality.




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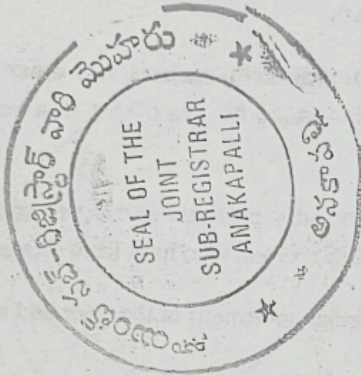
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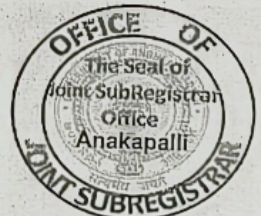
16. To Organize programmers and projects for an integrated community its welfare, and development.

23. To acquire land by purchase, lease or otherwise and carry on the activity of agriculture, horticulture, floriculture, sericulture, apiculture etc., and use it for any other purpose and activity or trust.
24. To identify the potentials in the youth and to evolve self-employment programmes to fully utilize these potentials.
25. To organize intensive campaigns on different social issues and evolve healthy public awareness on these issues.
26. To establish data-bank on the needs pertaining to different groups the society and to scientifically plan and organize need based programmes in a most cost effective manner.
27. To establish youth groups and train them for self-help and leadership development, train them in planning as well as in implementing various programmes. The focus of the programmes should be to develop confidence and capability of the youth.
28. To make necessary efforts to identify and mobilize the resources required to, organize and implement community development programmes, in tribal, rural and urban areas.
29. To build co-operative and collaborative efforts to make peoples participation productive, interesting and stimulating.



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
30. To Secure affiliation to any federation or organization recognized by the government at National and international levels.

7. TRUSTEES:-

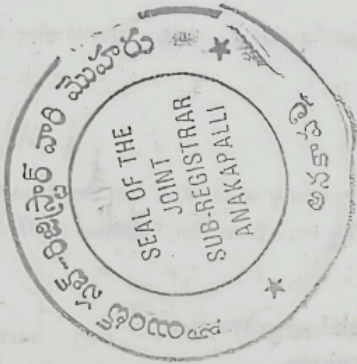
The Trust shall be governed by a Board of Trustees. The number of trustees on the board shall always be not less than three and not more than nine. The First Board of Trustees shall consist of:-

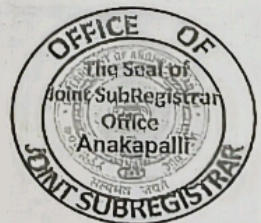
- The Managing trustee shall be continued from the same family and their legal heirs in future with an intention for perpetual attainment of the objects of the Trust.
8. On execution of this deed, The Board of Trustees shall take charge of the said sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees TEN THOUSAND Only) and it will be the corpus of the trust and it shall not be spent off or subjected to any kind of charge for the purpose of meeting the expenses or for carrying out the objectives of the trust or for any other purpose unless otherwise resolved unanimously by the Board of Trustees.
 9. The Board of Trustees shall stand possessed of the said amount of corpus and such other properties (both movable and immovable) as shall be designed as the properties of the Trust. **There are no immovable properties in the name of trust at present.**
 10. The Board of Trustees shall have power from time to time to increase or decrease the corpus of the trust.
 11. The Board of Trustees is hereby authorized and empowered to nominate one of them as the Chairman or Managing Trustee.
 12. The First Chairman and Managing Trustee of the Board of Trustees shall be Sri. Konathala Raghunadh. The Other trustee shall help, co-operate and co-ordinate with the managing trustee to realize the objects of the Trust.



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
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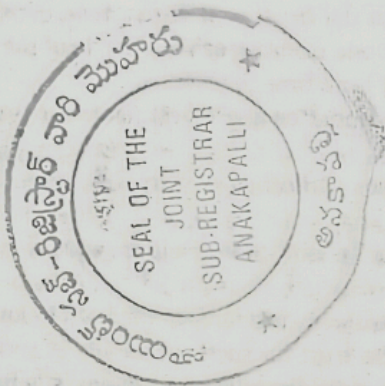
13. The Board of Trustees is hereby authorized and empowered to nominate any other person or persons as trustee or trustees as long as the number of trustees do not exceed nine.
14. The Managing Trustee is empowered to nominate any other person or persons that he may think fit and proper to act as Trustee or Trustees in place of a dead Trustee or Trustee refusing to act as a Trustee. And the Trustee so appointed will have the same powers and rights as the One he or she is replacing.

15. POWERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

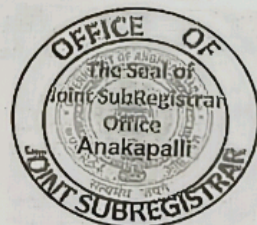
- 1) The Board of Trustees shall have the control and management of the trust and exercise the following powers.
- 2) To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind, from any person(s), body of persons or trust, with or without conditions.
- 3) To apply the whole or any part of the income of the trust, or the trust fund except the corpus or accumulations thereof, to realize any one or more of the objects of the trust, as the trustees may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
- 4) To Convert and deal with the trust's property and / or any investments for the time being.
- 5) To invest the trust fund in immovable properties and other investments, from time to time at the discretion of the trustees.
- 6) To borrow or raise or secure moneys and also to lend money either with or without security.
- 7) To Sell, dispose off, alienate or otherwise deal with any property of the trust in future.
- 8) To let out, immovable property belonging to the trust for such period and at such rates on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may deem fit in future.
- 9) To Open account or accounts in the name of the trust, Trustees and / or institutions run / conducted by the trust with a Bank of Banks, to operate such account and to give instructions to the Bank and to provide for opening and operation of such accounts by the Managing Trustee only or by an agent appointed by the Managing Trustee.
- 10) To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust Fund.
- 11) To enter into agreements / contracts / covenants with any government / public / private Body(s) persons for taking up any project(s) for fulfillment of the objectives of the trust, with or without monitory considerations.
- 12) To appoint, constitute, attorneys or agents and to delegate to such attorneys or agents all or any of the powers vested on them attorneys or agents and to appoint others in their place. Any Trustee or any authorized person authorized by the Board of Trustees can sue on or at any legal or quasi-legal platform on behalf of the Trust.
- 13) To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the Trustees and committees or administrator or managing Trustees or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of this deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may from time to time think fit make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.




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- 14) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity of charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.
- 15) To set apart and / or allocate the whole or a part of the income on the corpus of the trust fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the trust.
- 16) To join, co-operate or amalgamate this trust with other or others having kindred or allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this trust.
- 17) To give aid by way of donations out of the income on the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organizations or trusts in India which may have been established or which may hereafter be established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institution, societies, organization or Trustees to start maintain, or carry out such charitable objects.
- 18) To settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- 19) To borrow moneys either on the security of any property comprised in the trust fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposed purpose of these presents, and its shall be lawful for the trustees to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- 20) To accept donations charities gifts alms etc from the devotes public I,e Individual, Corporate bodies, Trusts, Societies, Business Entities and other Organizations all over the World for sustenance, maintenance and development of Trust and for utilize the same for attaining its objectives mentioned herein or for such other objectives as may be decided.
- 21) To apply to the Government, Quasi-Government public bodies, urban, local, municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, and persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to confirm to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
- 22) To take over or amalgamate with any other charitable Trust, society, association or institution with similar projects.
- 23) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- 24) To transfer all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagements of this Trust to any one or more of the trust, Societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate in future.

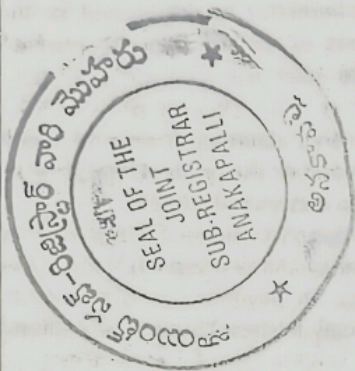


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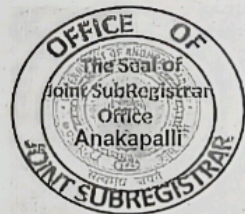
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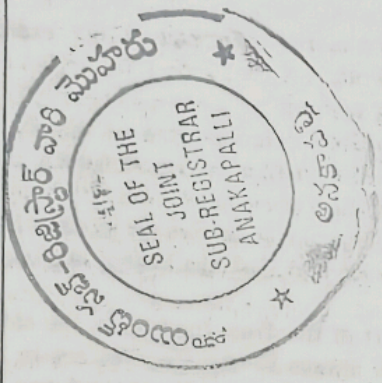
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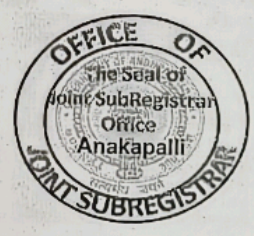
- 25) To transfer and hand over the Trust to any other Society, Corporation, Institution, Trust or Organization on such terms and condition as the Trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit and proper to be held by the society, Corporation, institution, Trust or organization with the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations, appearing and contained in these presents subject to such modifications as may be necessary and consequent to such transfer of the Trust Fund. The Trustees for the time being of these presents shall become discharged from the Trust thereof relating to Trust Funds so transferred.
- 26) In addition to discharging normal duties of a trustee, the managing Trustee shall preside over meeting of the Board of Trustees. The Managing Trustee is authorized to sign all documents, acknowledgements for the contributions received, and agreements with individuals, Government Institutions and other organizations, on behalf of the Board of Trustees. The Managing Trustee shall have all the residuary powers not explicitly assigned to any of the other officers in these presents.
- 27) The Managing Trustee is authorized to sign along with the bank cheques, deposits and other negotiable instruments. The Managing Trustee is empowered to remove any Trustee from the Trust and its offices if he/she found that his/her activities or not congenial to the activities of the Trust without any show cause Notice.
- 28) The Managing Trustee is responsible for ensuring that the Trust pursues its Objects and for maintaining the dignity of the Trust organization and shall use his/her influence to promote the activities of the Trust.
- 16) All contributions shall be treated as forming part of the Trust fund being the subject matter of these presents provided that it shall always be for the Trustees in their absolute discretion to decide whether they should invite and / or accept any such contribution without giving any reason for such refusal.
- 17) It shall be competent for the Board of Trustees from time to time to frame make and enforce all such rules, regulations and/ or bye- laws consistent with the express provisions of this Trust as the Board of Trustees may deem proper for securing and facilitating the administration and management in detailed affairs of the Trust and for convening conducting and regulating the meeting of the Board of Trustees and for appointing sub-committees for the management and administration of the Trust Estate and also from time to time to repeal alter, amend, rescind or add to all such rules, Regulations and Bye-laws and also to pass resolutions in connection with all or any of the said matters at their meeting.
- 18) The Trust can appoint Volunteers Who are willing to serve the objects of the Trust Whole-heartedly with zeal and interest for partial remuneration or without remuneration as a free seva to the cause of the Bharatamma goddess.
- 19) For the regular execution of the Trust activities an Administrative Committee or Executive Committee consisting of not less than three and not more than nine persons shall be constituted the said Administrative Body shall carryout and execute the policies and programmes formulated by the Board of Trustees The Board of Trustees shall be competent to continue or discontinue such administrative body and make changes there in, as and when it thinks fit The Board may entrust such functions to the Administrative Body as it deems fit from time to time.




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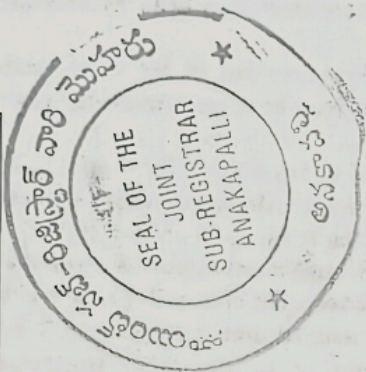
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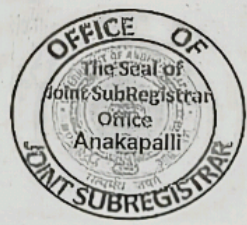
- 20) The Board or Administrative Committee or executive Committee shall power and authority to appoint or engage and at their discretion remove, dismiss or suspend one or more secretaries, Treasurers, supervisors, cashiers, Accounts and other officials or employees and persons in permanent, temporary or special service in connection with the trust.
- 21) The Trustees shall have power in general to acquire all things and do all acts necessary to carry out the subjects of the Trust including economic activity to improve the financial strength of the Trust.
- 22) The Trustees shall be entitled to reimburse themselves out of the Trust Estate all expenses incurred in or about the execution of the Trust or Powers herein or in carrying out the trust, its objects and affairs.
- 23) The Trustees shall not be entitled in normal course to any remuneration and shall work in an honorary capacity. Trustees shall function without introducing any self-interest and shall only fulfill the goals set by the objects of the Trust.
- 24) The Trustees shall have power to deposit the Trust moneys or any portion thereof in any Bank or Banks by way of fixed deposits or in current account or in savings Bank Account. Bank accounts on behalf of the Trust shall be opened and operated either by the Managing Trustee Sri. KONATHALA RAGHUNADH or by the other trustees Smt. KONATHALA RANAJI or KONATHALA ANUSHA SUBRAHMANYAM or by another trustee as may be decided by the Managing Trustee in writing and supported by the resolution by the Board of Trustees.
- 25) For the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Trust, the Board of Trustees shall have power to acquire any land by purchase or on lease and in case of vacant land to erect buildings thereon and to do all acts necessary and incidental thereto.
- 26) It shall be lawful for the Board of Trustees to pull down, renovate, rebuild, alter, adopt, improve, add to, develop or repair any immovable property comprised in the trust properties and to expend thereon such moneys out of the trust fund or income thereof as they may think fit.
- 27) The Board of Trustees may deposit for safe custody the documents held by them relating to any property belonging to the trust under these presents with any Bank and may pay any sym payable in respect of the same.
- 28) The entire control, regulation, management, application and administration of the Trust properties whether capital or income, rent, interest, profit or any kind shall be in the discretion of the Board of Trustees.
- 29) Every power, authority or discretion conferred upon the Board of Trustees shall be exercised or signified either by some instruments in writing to be signed by all of the Board of Trustees or such of them as may present at a particular board meeting or by a resolution of the Board of Trustees or such of them as may be present there and vote at any meeting of the Board of Trustees.
- 30) In case of difference of opinion arising among the Board of Trustees and in all matters wherein the Board of Trustees and in all matters wherein the Board of Trustees shall have a discretionary power and opinion of the majority of the Board of Trustees present and voting shall prevail and be binding on the majority as well as on those Board of Trustees, who may not have voted and if the Board of Trustees shall be equally divided in opinion the matter shall be decided according to the casting vote of the Chairman.




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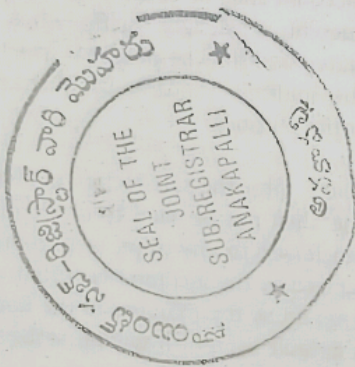
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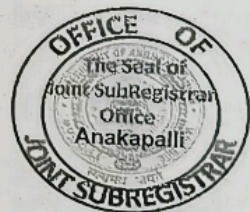
- 31) The meeting of Board of Trustees shall be held at least once in a year but any number of other meetings may be held as and when considered necessary.
- 32) A minute Book shall be kept by the Trustees. Minutes of the entry into office of every new trustee and all proceedings of the meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be entered in the minute Book and shall be signed by the chairman of the meeting either at the conclusion thereof or at the next meeting or when they shall have been fully comprised.
- 33) Proper and regular Books of Accounts of all receipts and expenditure of the trust shall be maintained by the Board of Trustees in English or any other convenient languages.
- 34) On the 31st day of March of every year a general account shall be taken of all the assets and liabilities of the trust and an income and expenditure account for the whole year and a balance sheet as on 31st march shall be prepared and shall be passed by the Board of Trustees. The accounts of the trust shall be audited annually by a chartered accountant appointed by the Board of Trustees for the purpose.
- 35) In the event of dissolution of the trust, there remains, after the satisfaction of all debts and liabilities, and property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among members of the trust shall be given or transferred to any other institution with the similar objects and aims which has been recognized by the income tax authorities as registered u/s 12A of the Income Tax act as determined by the majority of the Board of Trustees on or before the time of dissolution. In default thereof it will be settled by a judge of High Court of Andhra Pradesh.
- 36) It is manually considered that the objects of the trust will be better achieved if the income of the trust will be better achieved if the income of the trust is exempt under the income tax act in case, however, a particular clause or clauses of the instrument of trust has been inadvertently clothes in a language capable of an interpretation in conflict with the relevant provisions granting exemption under the income tax Act, it is hereby agreed that such clause or clauses will have restricted meanings to that the relevant income tax provision will always have overriding effect.
- 37) No alterations, amendments, deletions or additions to this deed or to any clause thereof shall however be made without the prior approval of the Commission of Income Tax, Andhra Pradesh.
- 38) For matters not provided for in these presents, the provisions of the Indian Trust act and the income tax act, 1961 and rules made there under will apply accordingly.



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
